RESOLUTION FY 2024-30

AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FUNDING AGREEMENT BETWEEN WOOD COUNTY ADAMHS BOARD AND WOOD COUNTY CHILDREN'S SERVICES ASSOCIATION dba CHILDREN'S RESOURCE CENTER

April 29, 2024

WHEREAS, R.C. 340.036 requires that the ADAMHS Board enter contracts for (1) public and private facilities for the operation of facility services; (2) community addiction service providers for addiction services and recovery supports; and (3) community mental health service providers for mental health services and recovery supports;

WHEREAS, the Board wishes to engage the Provider in the provision of behavioral health facilities and to ensure the continued use of these facilities for behavioral health services;

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services (hereinafter OhioMHAS) has awarded the Board \$6,646,703.00 in the American Rescue Plan Act (hereinafter "ARPA") Crisis Infrastructure Expansion funding (Federal CFDA 21.027) on behalf of Provider; and

WHEREAS, the Provider will utilize funding to provide a full continuum youth crisis center for the Northwest Region to be used as described in the Provider's approved Application for Community Planning and Collaboration; and

WHEREAS, Provider has not requested additional funding from the Board for this Project; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the BOARD approves the Agreement with Children's Resources Center to provide OhioMHAS ARPA funding for the Crisis Infrastructure Expansion, total amount not to exceed \$6,646,703.00, source of funds Federal CFDA 21.027.
